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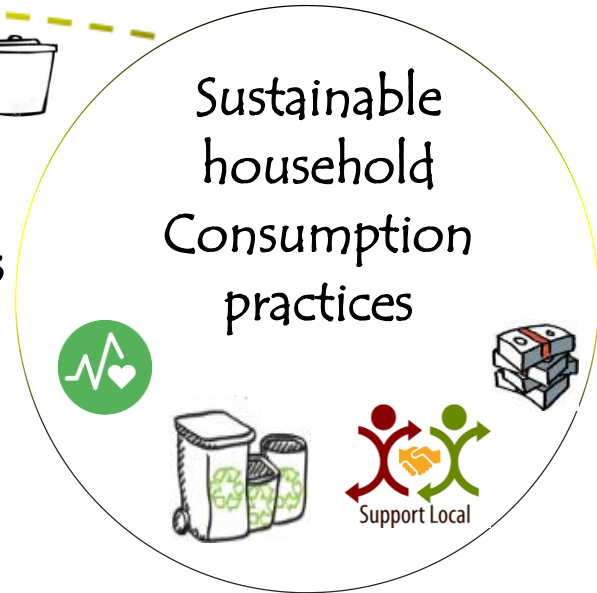
Food practices in focus



Innovative food provisioning systems

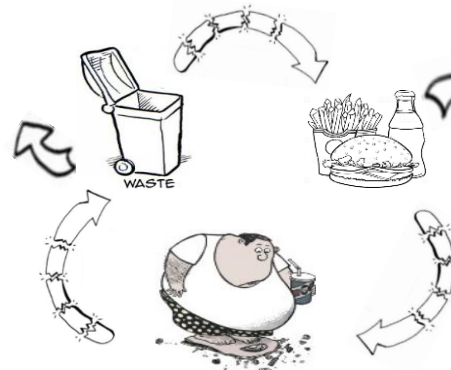


Focus on a bundle of household food practices



Can innovations in the way food enters the household make consumption more Sustainable?

e.g. Consumption waste
114.3 Kg/ Per capita/year



In Ireland, 1 in 4 adults & 1 in 4 children is classed as obese

Unsustainable food consumption practices



Project aims:

- Promote sustainable practices through direct involvement with households.
- Communicate findings with local food providers that may directly impact the way in which they offer their product/service.

Future interventions:

- Contribute to both consumption and public policy efforts in attainment of a more sustainable Irish Agri-food system.
- Ensuring that both the national suppliers of food provisioning platforms and the consumers are sustainable in practice.
- Future attainment of socio-technical innovations by food suppliers and consumers.
