

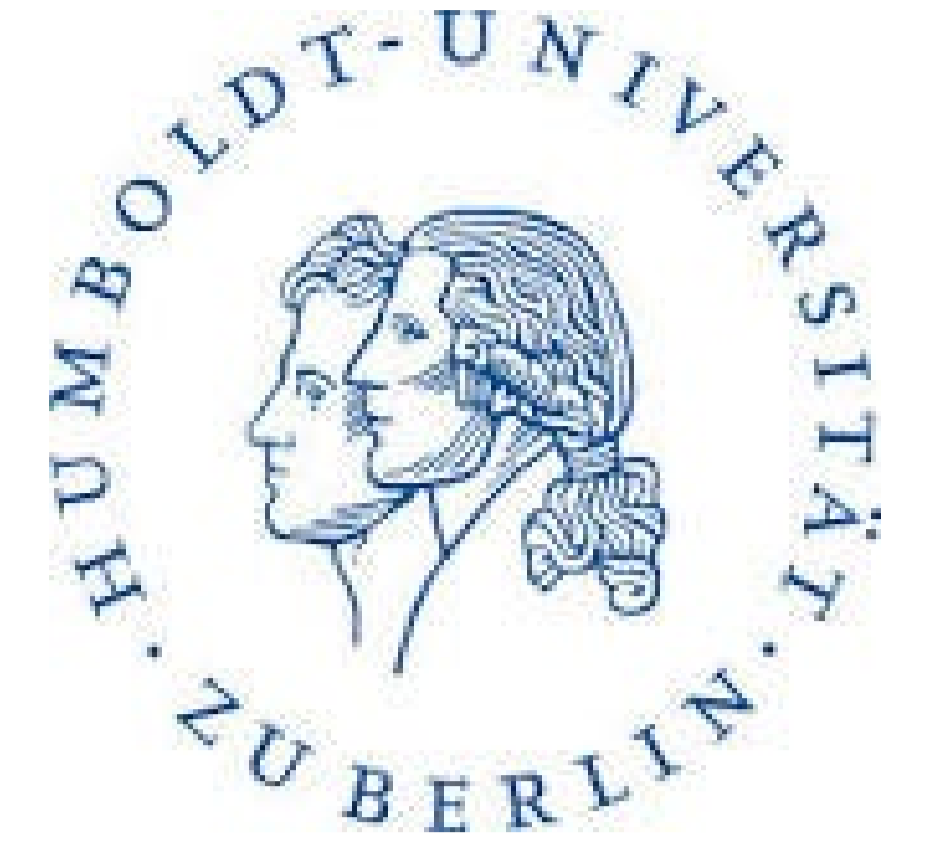

Point of Departure

In recent years, the range of food provisioning platforms has increased, offering new ways and opportunities of food procurement for the household.



So far, little is known about the influences of those socio-technical innovations on the actual food practices in the household.

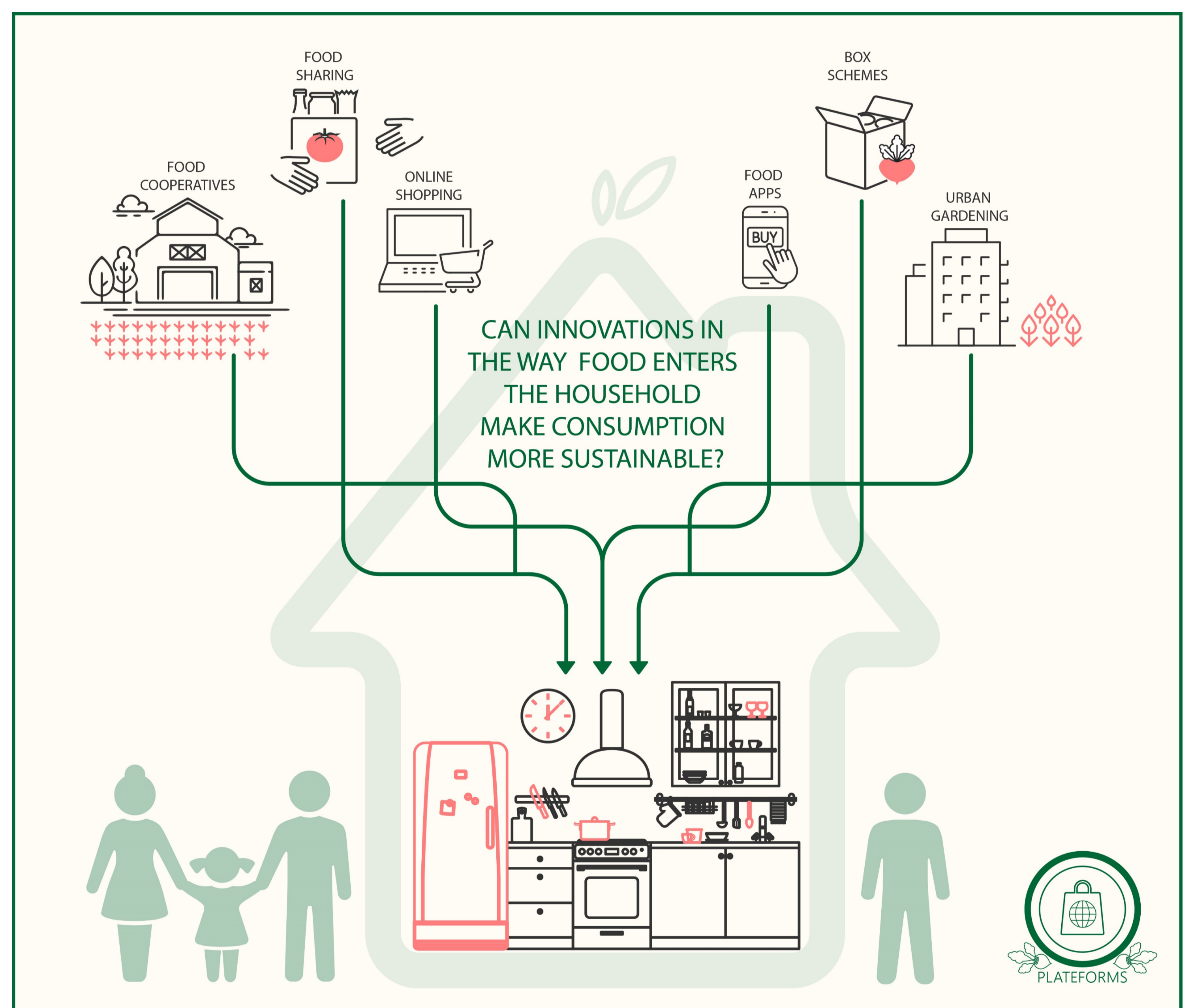
Research Question

How are food practices affected by socio-technical innovations in food provisioning platforms?

- What potentials and challenges emerge at the household level?
- In particular, what potentials and challenges emerge with regard to the gendered division of labor?

Methodology

- Quantitatively depicting options for food provisioning in and around Berlin
- Analysing food practices and meal cultures in households through qualitative-participatory methods (kitchen stories)



Aim

- In-depth knowledge about linkages between (sustainable) food practices and socio-technical innovations in food provisioning
- Contribute to the discussion about a sustainable food system
