The upshot? Soziere says it all in his title.

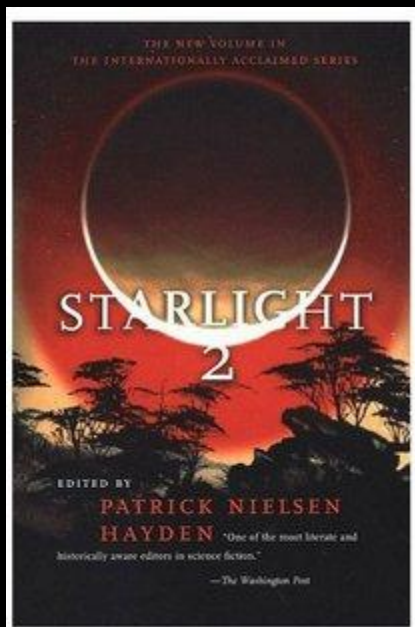

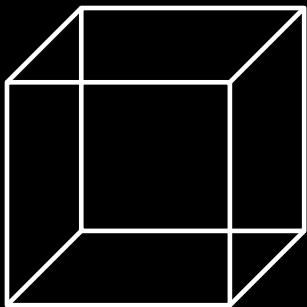

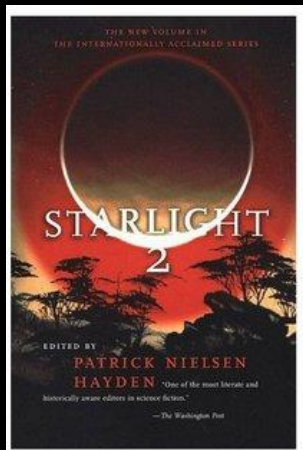
