I research job-related wellbeing in the past and present, focusing on the effects of technology and disease outbreaks. My PhD at Oxford analyzed the impact of innovation on work from the Industrial Revolution to the 20th century. More broadly, I study the quality of employment—what makes a "good job"—and how to prepare workers, firms, and economies for automation and pandemics.

Before my PhD, I was a Research Associate for the nationally-acclaimed housing assistance organization <u>Jericho</u>

<u>Project</u>. I also contributed to the <u>Freedom on the Move</u> project and helped to compile <u>American Capitalism: A Reader</u>.

- Get an ORCiD and maintain it
- Connect your online profiles to a main 'hub'
- Decide whether you want a personal and/or professional digital presence
- Use an appropriate picture online (preferably use the same picture on all profiles)
- Maximize the potential of your research profiles to improve your network
- Publish open access (and deposit your articles in open repositories)
- Publish your data along with your research articles
- Share summaries of your research on social media
- Be an expert for funders such as the EU, and the media
- Link to your latest articles in your email signature
- Write guest posts on other people's blogs for more visibility
- Track your online visibility (number of downloads, citations, etc.)


